

PRIVACY POLICY

As a personal data operator with a registered office in Italy at PIAZZA ROMA 4, 22061 CAMPIONE D'ITALIA and in accordance with EU Regulation 679/2016, 25 effective May 2018 – General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) – INTEGRA EVENTS SRL recognizes the importance of protecting personal data and considers this protection to be one of the company's primary tasks.

In accordance with the provisions of EU Regulation 679/2016 and applicable national legislation (the "GDPR" and "applicable national legislation" hereinafter collectively referred to as "Applicable Laws"), we hereby provide you with important information concerning the processing of personal data provided. This notice is provided in accordance with Applicable Laws. We invite you to read it carefully, as it contains important information on the protection of personal data and the security measures taken to ensure confidentiality in full compliance with Applicable laws.

INTEGRA EVENTS SRL hereby informs you that the processing of your personal data must take place in accordance with the principles of legality, correctness, transparency, targeted restrictions and restrictions on storage, data minimization, accuracy, integrity, and confidentiality. For this reason, personal data must be processed in accordance with the legal provisions of the Applicable Laws and the obligations provided for their confidentiality.

1. DATA SUBJECTS

On the basis of the Applicable Laws, the personal data operator is INTEGRA EVENTS SRL, with a registered office at PIAZZA ROMA 4, 22061 CAMPIONE D'ITALIA, with the email address info@integraevents.it.

INTEGRA EVENTS SRL hereby informs you that the contact person for processing operations is the organizational manager of the marketing department acting as the confidentiality manager.

Furthermore, a data protection officer who can be contacted at the email address dpo@canali.it for all information regarding processing of personal data by INTEGRA EVENTS SRL, including a list of data owners, has been appointed at INTEGRA EVENTS SRL.

2. TYPES OF DATA WE COLLECT AND PROCESS

Personal Data and Identity Data

Personal data refers to any information relating to individuals who are identified or can be identified, even indirectly, by reference to any other information, including a personal identification number. Identity data refers to any personal data that allows you to directly identify the data subject (for example, name, last name, date of birth, address, email address, phone number, etc.).

Navigation data

In the course of their usual operation, the computer systems and software procedures used to operate the Website collect certain personal data that is automatically transmitted under Internet communication protocols. We do not collect this information

in order to associate it with identified data subjects. However, due to its nature and its processing and comparison with other data stored by third parties, the information may allow users to be identified. This data category includes IP addresses or domain names of computers of users logging in to the Website, URIs (Uniform Resource Identifier) of the requested resources, request time, the method employed to apply to the server, the size of the file received in response, a code showing the status of the response provided by the server (successful completion, error, etc.), as well as additional parameters related to the operating system and computing environment of the data subject.

Data on persons under the age of 18

INTEGRA EVENTS SRL does not knowingly collect personal data about persons under the age of 18, and INTEGRA EVENTS SRL may not be held liable for false information submitted by persons under the age of 18. Should INTEGRA EVENTS SRL be found to have collected personal information from a child under the age of 18, it shall immediately delete such information. The data operator shall provide assistance to legal guardians or persons with parental responsibility in requests for personal data of minors in accordance with Applicable Laws.

Third party data

Data provided by users voluntarily

E-mails sent independently and voluntarily by the user directly to the addresses indicated on this Website include the sender's address, which is necessary to respond to any request, as well as additional personal data contained in the messages. Specific consolidated information notifications will be shown and/or displayed on pages used to provide services on demand.

3. DATA PROCESSING OBJECTIVES

The personal data you provide voluntarily will be processed for the following purposes.

Personal data shall be processed for the purpose of fulfilling the agreement to organize participation in the Tashkent International Investment Forum (hereinafter referred to as the Forum), conducted by INTEGRA EVENTS SRL, and allowing the user to access the Forum territory and Forum services.

Consent shall be given to the processing of the following personal information: full name, gender, date and place of birth, passport data (citizenship, series, number, by whom and when the document was issued), address of registration at the place of residence and actual residence, phone number (home and mobile), information related to place of work/study, and a photograph.

4. MAINTENANCE

The data subject's personal information may be processed with the use of additional methods and for other purposes related to the maintenance of the Website.

5. PROCESSING AND STORAGE METHODS

Processing shall be carried out automatically or manually with the use of methods and tools aimed at ensuring maximum security and confidentiality, as determined by the parties responsible for processing, in accordance with the provisions of the Applicable Laws. Data shall be stored for a period of time not exceeding that, which is strictly necessary to achieve the purpose for which the data was collected and then processed.

6. TRANSFER AND DISTRIBUTION

Processed data may be transferred to third parties. The data may be transferred for the purposes listed above in relation to companies and/or those controlled thereby, as well as companies and institutions associated with agreements/contracts with INTEGRA EVENTS SRL. These companies may be foreign, within the European Union or beyond, in full compliance with the Applicable Laws. In particular, third parties may belong to the following categories:

- company staff of that of another company.

If you have given your consent to the actions indicated in these objectives, your data will be transferred to entities specially indicated in writing and authorized to access the INTEGRA EVENTS SRL corporate customer relationship management system, as well as to staff. Parties falling into the above-mentioned categories shall act as data processor or work entirely independently as separate data operators.

7. SECURITY PROCEDURES AND DENIAL

In accordance with the instructions drawn up regarding navigation data, users may provide personal data in application forms and/or voluntarily send the data to the contact address for the purpose of requesting information and/or services provided. Failure to provide such data may result in a denial of the requested services.

8. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

Within the framework of the Applicable Laws, the data subject reserves the right to ask INTEGRA EVENTS SRL at any time to provide access to the subject's personal data, to correct or erase the data or to prevent its processing, as well as to require restrictions on its processing and collection in a structured, commonly used, and machine readable format.
